Availability

Available to residential consumers, except as another approved rate may be applicable, and subject to the established rules and regulations of the district covering these types of services.

Types of Service

Single phase, at available secondary voltages.

Energy Charge:	All Kilowatt hours Per kWh	\$0.1013

Budget Billing

Rate R-BB-22

Budget billing will be available to existing residential consumers with good credit performance and upon acceptance of a properly completed transfer of rate form. Consumers will be able to apply for the budget billing rate prior to May 21st of each year. Note: Policy 0-9

Minimum Charge

The minimum charge shall be the Access charge of the rate in effect. Payment of the minimum charge shall entitle the consumer to have service available.

Terms of Payment

The above rates are net, the gross rate being 10 percent of the net higher. In the event the current monthly bill is not paid by date of delinquency, the gross rate shall apply. Interest charges shall apply as established by District Policy.

Billing period – Means from meter reading to meter reading and thereby establishing billing months.
